Identification of simple and resistant forms of the common diseases of reptiles in captivity such as oropharyngeal infections ("mouth rot", or canker), respiratory infections, skin diseases and shell diseases are all included. Selection of correct antibiotics, proper dosage schedules for the new aminoglycoside drugs and other new antibiotics, as well as combination therapy are addressed. A section of color photographs of the diseases discussed is included. Over 130 pages in length, the text is written for the serious herpetologist. A cross index of antibiotics is included for European herpetologists.


