A correction to the dosage of Levamisole (Ripercole-L) for snakes and lizards.

In the handbook "Krankheiten der Heimtiere" by Zwart, P. & K. Gabrisch (Eds.) on page 308 it states the dosage as 200 mg/kg bodyweight; this must be 50 mg/kg bodyweight.

The readers are asked to take notice and correct their copy.

It has been shown that for *Boidae*, for parenteral administration (intraabdominal), the lowest advised dose of 30 mg/kg bodyweight has to be administered.
