For several species of rattlesnakes parturition may occur a considerable distance from the hibernaculum used by adults. Field observations however indicate that many neonatal Crotalus viridis and Crotalus horridus do use the same winter refugia as adults. During field observation the authors saw young Crotalus horridus trailing adults towards their hibernacula.
