■ REPTILE HOUSE 'SERPO'



■ REPTILE EXCHANGE IN OPWIJK, BELGIUM

The workgroup snakes Medusa organizes an exchange of reptiles on Sunday the 15th of September 1996. The purpose is to present or to exchange the progeny among terraria-devotees. The exchange will take place in the Cultural Center in Opwijk, 'Hof ten Hemelrijk', Kloosterstraat 7, 1745 Opwijk, Belgium, from 09.30 am to 17.00 pm.

Terraria-devotees should offer their animals in solid plastic boxes or microterraria in which the animals can clearly be observed and on which the name (scientific and common) is mentioned. It is forbidden to sell or even to offer poisonous snakes in the Cultural Center and on the parking of the Center!!.

All reptiles and amphibians and arachnids are allowed. People who want to sell animals, protected by the "Convention of Washington", need to have the required papers. Belgian reptiles (including the native snakes Coronella austriaca, Natrix natrix and Vipera berus) are protected by federal law and can not be sold or offered. Reservation for a stand is preferable but not obligatory. One can reserve until the 10th of September 1996. People who have reserved a stand are asked to be present before 09.00 am.






■ MEETING OF REPTILES AND INVERTEBRATES IN FRANCE


